Principal's Update– Todd Corsetti

- 1 teacher being added at semester and additional sections of some classes by supersizing some teacher schedules so they teach a class during their prep. No course schedule changes will be allowed.
- MHS is beholden to transportation for getting kids to the pool for swim practice. We're the only campus that doesn't have a pool or access to THPRD.
- Working out solutions for 9th and 10th graders who have a gap in their math due to advancement in middle school who can't start the IB program until 11th grade.
